



In order to optimize the internal reuse of office furniture and provide the users with an overview of the available inventory, the City of Copenhagen opened the CHP Warehouse and webshop to the employees in late January 2024. The East of Denmark CEO pilot became an instant success with a turnover of used office furniture corresponding to DKK

The purpose of CPH Warehouse is to achieve reductions in both procurement costs and CO2 footprint. The pilot is aiming at a reduction of the yearly procurement costs for office

To give employees the best possible incentive to choose used furniture over new purchases, the pilot is funded by the reduction in the procurement costs enabling the
