



Output and results

Fixed set of indicators to measure the performance of projects (and the programme)

Report in OMS, not linked to reporting period

Outputs

Defined on work package level.

There are two output indicators

- 1. Pilot actions developed jointly and implemented in projects
- 2. Strategies and action plans jointly developed

The achievement will be a logical consequence of the activities carried out in the respective work package.

Results

Capture the accumulated benefits of all work packages.

There are three result indicators:

- 1. Solutions taken up or up-scaled by organisations
- 2. Joint strategies and action plans taken up by organisations
- 3. Organisations with increased institutional capacity due to their participation in cooperation activities across borders

Each result indicator links to an output indicator and measures the wider uptake of the corresponding output.


Three work packages



How did we report on achievement?

- Idea: we coordinate, partners report, WP leads report
- We asked partners to report on their NbS pilots (16), but not yet on their action plans (9)
- We will ask WP leads to report on strategies: mainstreaming strategy (1) and capacity building instruments (1)

Feedback from JS: what could be improved

- The entries for the pilots are very different. Make sure to describe the main goals and how this can be achieved
- The entries should focus on actual progress; not that the MANABAS project has been presented at an event
- Some descriptions could be improved
- Some entries that refer to several pilot sites
- Not all pilots reported on progress
- There is an empty entry

- We advise to wait a bit with reporting on this indicator because you might involve the same organisation at a later stage and they might then increase their institutional capacity in yet another field.

Our learnings/ tips & tricks

- Start early, learn early
- Agree on who will report what, when
 - Strategy: WP lead
 - · Pilot or action plan: partners
 - Organisations: partners (divide the load!)
- Only start reporting, when there has been progress
- Provide guidance on how to report: progress against goal
- Create a deadline: combine with activity report
- Check input from WP leads/ partners before submission

- Strategy: a new, additional document that synthesizes results from all activities in the WP. This could be a report that will feed into the actual strategy/ strategies.
- Pilot: Proof of evidence depends on the type of pilot/ activities. It could be a photo with writing or links to news items
- Results: Stories about uptake by takers
