Rules of the Game

- Step 1** Stand up and stay in the middle of the u-shaped categories.

- Step 3** Allocate ONE of the five statements to each category, from strongly disagree (-2) to neutral (0) to strongly agree (+2). Indicate this on the questionnaire. **NOTE: Only one statement per category is possible**
- Step 4** Each statement will be considered in turn. The different rankings are set out around the room. The facilitators will guide you through the process.
- Step 5** Explain and discuss your decision with the entire group
- Step 6** Repeat from step 4 until all statements are considered or until we run out of time!
- Step 7** After discussing all statements you will be able to change your initial ranking
