





A young and global city

- Sweden's third largest city
- Population: 357 377 (31/1 2022)
- Malmö is the fastest growing large city in Sweden
- A global city: One third of Malmö's inhabitants were born abroad
- 186 different nationalities (2022),
 150 different languages
- A young city: 48% under the age of 35




Climate transition Malmö: "We can only succeed together."






A just transition?

- Who is involved and participating in decisions (political, research and financial)?




Climate change means climate injustice

October 12-13

- Organized by Klimatriksdagen (the Climate Parliament association,) in collaboration with the City of Malmö
- 40 Malmö residents, including 4 politicians. 10 observers from research and other municipalities
- Co funded by Speak Up
- Task: to develop locally adapted proposals for improving Malmö's climate work, to be submitted to the Environmental Committee




